

Tips for creating a meaningful environmental policy



What is an environmental policy and why should you have one?

An environmental policy is a written statement that outlines your businesses commitment to net zero and tackling the climate emergency. Having an environmental policy can influence the decision-making process in your business, help you meet legal requirements, reduce costs and attract new business. Below are some steps to consider when writing your policy:



Make sure the policy is **unique** to your business and reflects your company ethos. Businesses are at varying stages of their journey to net zero and will have different areas they need to prioritise – make sure you embrace and reflect this in your policy.

Consult staff, partners and stakeholders. It is vital **everyone** understands the importance and risk that climate change and nature loss pose so they can understand their role they have to play in tackling it; in both their **personal** and **professional** lives. To make a policy viable you need buy in, if you employ staff involve them in the **creation process** and build in **accountability**.





Make sure it addresses your businesses environmental impacts. If you have an understanding of your **baseline emissions** and scope then make sure the policy outlines how you can make positive action on these.
