Understand your business proposals carbon footprint. Use a free online calculator such as **www.carbonfootprint.com/calculator.aspx** to baseline your new businesses carbon footprint

Use an environmentally friendly energy supplier. This may seem obvious but switching to green energy will make a massive difference to your businesses carbon footprint. If you are considering premises then ask the landlord about current power supply, insulation and energy performance of the building

Counteract any residual CO2 emissions by carbon offsetting, this is not as confusing as it sounds. The Carbon Offset Guide has information for businesses here www.offsetguide.org/understanding-carbon-offsets/

Certify your business or products as carbon neutral via the Carbon Trusts PAS 2060 certification. This is a great marketing tool with research suggesting consumers are willing to pay more for products or services from environmentally conscious companies.
