The Advice Shop delivers a free, impartial and confidential advice service to help households in West Lothian including the following areas:

- Welfare Benefits
- Money, budgeting & Debt Advice
- Housing Advice Advice on preventing homelessness, disrepair issues, rent arrears/evictions
- Energy Advice looking at energy efficiency and ways to reduce bills or access further support if required

Trained advisors will complete a benefit check and look at options to maximise income, reduce expenditure and access other appropriate financial support. Better off benefit calculations can also be completed for those looking to start or change employment.

The Scottish Welfare Fund helps people on a low income with the following:

- Crisis Grants if you're in crisis because of a disaster (like a fire or flood), or an emergency (like losing your money or job, or an unexpected expense)
- Self-Isolation Support Grant if you've been asked to self-isolate by Test and Protect because of coronavirus (COVID-19) and will lose income as a result
- Community Care Grant to help you or someone you care for to start to live or to carry on living a settled life in the community
